DIVISIONS:

The following divisions will be judged randomly between 6 p.m. – 8 p.m.:

- Market Steers
- Scramble Heifers
- Market Swine
- Market Lambs
- Market Goats

AWARDS:

When: Noon, Saturday, October 2, 2010

Where: George Barn Arena

What: Two belt buckles for each division will be awarded. There will be an overall award of \$100.00 presented to the Fort Bend County 4-H Club/FFA Chapter with the highest points total from all divisions combined.

REGISTRATION:

1. All exhibitors that want to enter the Good Housekeeping Contest must fill out a contest entry form. Entry forms can be obtained from the Livestock Office.
2. Completed entry form must be turned back into the Livestock Office by 4:30 p.m. on the day the contest starts for the particular division.
3. Exhibitors are encouraged to check the bulletin board at check-in for changes in rules/dates for the Good Housekeeping Contest.
4. Divisions will only be judged on general appearance the night of the Jr. Livestock Auction.
5. Animal must be in stall/pen to receive a score on cleanliness of animal

JUDGING RULES:

1. All divisions will be judged individually.
2. Judging will be on exhibitor's presence, cleanliness of animal, stall, and general appearance.
3. An exhibitor's sign must be in place (FFA, 4H or other) by 4:30 p.m. on the first day of judging.
4. Judging will be from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. nightly.
5. Judging will stop at 8 p.m., Friday, October 1, 2010
6. Possibly two (2) judgings per night
