Bad Company Rodeo Rockin' at the Fort Bend County Fair

The Fort Bend County Fair Rodeo will again feature livestock from Bad Company Rodeo and action from Pro Tour FMX, a freestyle motocross team.

The rodeo will be held during the last weekend of the fair, Oct. 2nd and 3rd. A special performance featuring timed events and bull riding will be held Oct. 1st. Legendary rodeo announcer Bob Tallman will be calling all of the action.

Pro Tour FMX will perform nightly following the events. The team is headed up by two former California and Arizona state motocross champions, D.J. Umphres and Brent Denton.
